Many are stranded and roads are impassable, making it difficult for people to leave and for emergency help to get in. North Carolina Relief Efforts

Eastern North Carolina has been hit multiple times with flooding over the past few years. They continue to be plagued with flooding

where low lying areas haven't drained properly. The problem has grown worse because waterways have not been cleared in the years since the flooding incidents. HB held several Kids Camps in Robeson County and many of our team members live there. Heart Bridge provided relief funds to the area through Burnt Swamp Baptist Association. They provide emergency relief for families in need, many of whom are still living in temporary cramped motel rooms since the flood.
